



Cultura Digital









Aprendizagem significativa

Group Work



Step 1: Sharing



- Share with your classmates your favorite type of stories.
- In your opinion, what is something a good story must have?
- Where do you hear/read most of these stories? Tv? Social Media?

Step 2: Brainstorming

Characters: Who are they? What are they like? Where are they from?

Setting: Where does it take place? When? How?

Conflict: What's it about? What's happening? What's the problem?

Closure: How is the issue solved? How does it all end?

Divide your story's lines (parts) for each person in the group. Each group participant must be one of the story's characters or the narrator if there is one.




Step 4: Practice

Step 6: Present


Play the recording for your Classmates.
